For many years the three friends come to Berlin for a weekend seminar. Giorgos Kapsalis gives a charming and knowledgeable insight into the world of folklore from Northern Greece. These are primarily dances from Epirus, his homeland. And of course the region of Thrace comes into its own. The seminar is complemented by dances from Central Macedonia.

The seminar unfolds its special quality through the interplay with the musicians. Fotis Karaviotis has an incredibly large repertoire especially of Epirotic and Macedonian music. He displays a magic all of his own with clarino and vocals. Giorgos Davliakos, on the other hand, leads the Thracian songs with gaida and vocals. Both musicians complement each other intuitively. As at the last seminars, they will be supported by Oliver Goers with defi, dauli and darabuka.

Berlin musicians will also be playing at the dance festival on Saturday. The seminar is aimed at both beginners with previous knowledge as well as experienced dancers. The language of instruction is English.
